World War 1 affected many people around the world just like today with the COVID-19 pandemic. Look at the list of people who helped the country and then draw or write a story about a person who lived during the war. You can research the different occupations and their uniforms or clothing on the internet.

Here is a list of people who were involved on the frontline during the war.

- Soldiers
- Nurses
- Doctors

Here is a list of people who were key workers for the war effort in Britain. People worked hard for everyone in the country.

Most of the men were soldiers in WW1 so women started doing the jobs that the men used to do.

- Doctors, nurses and support staff in hospitals and local medical centres.
- Postal workers – to keep people informed and connected.
- Food supplies – farmers, farm workers, shop workers, factory workers.
- Resources for the war effort – factory workers.
- People to transport resources.
- School teachers.

The Red Cross asked people to help with the war effort by helping in hospitals peeling potatoes, knitting socks and collecting moss for wound dressings.

Maybe you could contact your relatives and ask if they have any information about your ancestors who lived during World War One to get some ideas.
